There's no wrong or right way to do this - but be attempt to make tonight something of a prayer - connecting the everyday experience of the marketplace with God.

Take as much (or as little) time as you'd like to do this.

You might like to share what you come up with over dinner or just keep it as a personal reflection.

God

- Where is God tonight?
- Does this feel like a 'Godly' or 'Sacred' place? Why/Why Not?
- As you wander around what do you see that connects with what you know about the Kingdom of God?
- What might God be doing around you in the different elements of the market?
- In what ways could you as an individual join God in what he's doing? In what ways could we as a community?
- Spend some time simply listening for what God might be saying to you as you walk around.
- Where is the Church tonight?

Culture

- What do you observe about the world we live in tonight?
- What messages do you see around you in, in advertising, in the people and their actions and words etc. How do these messages connect and/or clash with God's Kingdom?
- In what ways are there examples of people engaging in spirituality here?
- What languages are being used here? (not just verbal ones)

You

- Be aware of how you're feeling going as you wonder around (body/mind/soul).
- How are you reacting to the things and people you see?
- How are your senses being engaged in this place?
- What do you like about this place and what do you dislike?
- What might God be saying to you? What challenges and opportunities might God be putting before you as you go home tonight?
